US FOREST SERVICE FACILITIES INITIATIVE EXPENSE-PAID INTERNSHIP

Join a cohort of 8 SCA Interns helping the US Forest Service to conduct facilities master planning efforts for the southern region! Interns will work and travel in pairs to survey forest facilities and infrastructure in an assigned National Forest (listed below). Some travel to other forests may be required. The data collected will help inform the forests' facilities master planning process.

- George Washington & Jefferson National Forest • Ouachita National Forest
- Ozark St. Francis National Forest • Daniel Boone National Forest

QUALIFICATIONS:

Preferably, interns will be currently working towards a degree in engineering, landscape architecture, or construction management. Interns must possess a valid driver's license as well as a clean driving record to be considered. Current First Aid/CPR certification is required.

Conditions of Employment: Beginning on 1/18/22, all new SCA volunteer program participants are required to be fully vaccinated for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) with a Food and Drug Administration (FDA) authorized or FDA approved COVID-19 vaccine. Full vaccination is defined as having received a booster shot six months after the Pfizer and Moderna primary series and two months after the Johnson & Johnson primary series. COMPENSATION:

- Travel Allowance: \$650 (paid once)
- Weekly Living Allowance: \$600/week
- SCA & USFS Training
- Housing Funding - Intern cohorts will have \$3000/month for housing related expenses as they travel. Each cohort will also have camping equipment provided by SCA for occasional camping.
- SCA rented vehicle - Each intern cohort will have a vehicle and fuel budget provided by SCA for the duration of the field portion of the program.
